Respected Sir,

In reference to the above mentioned subject, I am directed to bring your kind attention regarding unilateral transfer of DAOs/DAs Cadre members which was dispensed in the year 1997.

- (1) Divisional Accountants are being recruited through Combined Graduate Level Examination on all India basis conducted by Staff Selection Commission of Central Government in accordance with the Divisional Accountants Recruitment Rule 2017 in vogue. After getting selected, the eligible candidates give their preference of states but due to non availability of vacancies in their most preferred states, most of them allotted states which are far away from their most preferred/home state.
- (2) It is pertinent to mention here that the candidates who have joined as Divisional Accountant in the years 2008, 2009 & 2010 did not even get the scope to exercise their option regarding preference of state.
- (3) After joining in other than most preferred/ home state, Divisional Accountants serve in works departments offices which are spread in all over the state including

remote/ hard areas. This affects his/ her service life sacrificing his/ her owns family bonding and their socio-cultural life.

- (4) State Associations have requested AIF to take up the matter of unilateral transfer to your good office stating difficulties facing by cadre members.
- (5) Request transfer is considered in Railway Department as per guidelines mentioned in reference no. 2 wherein transfer of officials from one railway to another on grounds of special cases of hardships may be considered favourably by the railway administration.

In view of the above, AIF requests to your good office to extend the unilateral transfer policy to the DAOs/ DAs Cadre.
